Lego Robotics Challenge

On Thursday 9th November our senior robotics team consisting of students aged 10 - 12 competed in the First Lego League challenge.

We competed in the FLL robotics challenge because we thought it would be fun applying robotics with Lego. Our team consisted of 8 members: Brandyn, Kalan, Alex, Elijah, Kerry, Sravan, Andrew and Zac. Our coaches were Mr Pye, Miss Ridley and Mrs Ellis. We competed against other teams at Baulkham Hills North Public School. There were three key areas: the robot game, core values (teamwork skills) and the project. Our project was about telemetry, or "smart meters." We were the first team to present our project. We used our learning dispositions as during the REDS (Robot Executive Design Summary) the brain stopped working! Luckily we had brought a spare brain so we could compete in the robot game. We had a problem in the first round when the colour sensors stopped working but it was fixed afterwards. Each team member had a turn at the robot game, trying to earn as many points for our team as we could. Overall we came 2rd in the robot game. We also won the Robot Mechanical Design Award for the robot with the best hasel

Students will need to prepare and deliver a 1-2 minute speech to their House on why they should be a House Captain in 2018.


