## From the pen of the president

2018 is drawing to a close and I would like to say thank you to all the families, volunteers and P and C members for a fabulous 2018.

We have had a successful year, spending over \$100,000 to improve our school for our children. We have replaced the large shade sail over the K-2 cola area, built a new shade sail and concrete pad in front of the demountable classroom, boosted classroom resources and purchased over 40 laptops for our Stage 3 classes.

We have also been working hard to develop practical strategies to ease our parking issues around the school. I am pleased to announce that in late February 2019 we will trial a "rolling" kiss and drop area at the front of the school for afternoon pick-ups. Families will be issued with a name card to place on their visor and volunteers will work with our teachers on duty, to implement this system. This will mean that cars can drive up to the kiss and drop area, their family name will be called and children can be ushered quickly into their cars – allowing for a better flow of traffic. Thank you to Sen and Natalie O'Brien who have researched these systems at other schools. Stay tuned for more details at the beginning of Term 1 2019.

I am looking forward to an even more exciting 2019 as we celebrate our school's 150<sup>th</sup> birthday and host our Country Fair in October. 
