FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT

An update from your Strategic Direction 2 team

Semester 2 Formative Asessment Focus

This semester, staff at Dural Public School have been focusing on activating students as instructional resources for one another.

Some techniques being implemented in Dural classrooms might include:



STUDENTS CHECK PEERS WORK WITH MARKING SCHEMES

This is a technique that involves learners in their own learning. In this technique students exchange their work and use a familiar marking scheme that helps them evaluate a peer's work. Students then provide feedback.



ROUND-ROBIN

Used with larger or smaller groups of children, this technique involves students to work in a group and circulate their work to other members of the group. Each member adds a post-it note with suggestions for how to improve the work.

TRAFFIC LIGHTING PEERS WORK

After being taught how to provide feedback, students mark a peer's work to identify his/her level of understanding. Green light = understanding, Amber = not sure, Red = do not understand.





TWO STARS AND A WISH

Here, students exchange books and write two positive things (stars) about the work and one thing that s/he wishes the other child would do to make his/her work even better. The comments are specific to what the child could do to improve that piece of work.

IS YOUR CHILD IN YEAR 5?

Do they eat, breathe and sleep sport 24/7? Do they have leadership aspirations and qualities? Are they gracious in victory as well as defeat on the sporting field? Are they confident to speak at school assemblies? Are they a sporting role model for their peers and the younger years? Do they consistently model exceptional sporting behaviour and ideals? Are they willing to assist at carnivals and sports events? If so, you need to ask them......

DO YOU WANT TO BE A HOUSE CAPTAIN?

If the answer is YES to all of the above questions; then your child should nominate to be a Sport Captain in 2020.

Year 5 students need to see Mr Field to nominate themselves. Nominations open Thursday 14th November

Nominations close 3:20pm Friday 22th November. No further nominations will be accepted after this date.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be a Dural Public School Year 6 student in 2020
- Cannot be in the Leadership Team in 2020

Voting is open to all students from K-6 and will be held throughout the school from 2:40-3:20pm 27th November 2019. Voting is done within sport houses.

The top 4 in each house will be announced shortly afterwards, but students will not be told if they are a Captain or Vice-Captain until it is formally announced at the School Presentation Day Assembly.

Students will need to prepare and deliver a 1-2 minute speech to their House on why they should be a House Captain in 2020.
