Principal's Report ~ Milly Stone

Our dedicated teachers spent time informing parents of changes as notes had to be organised quickly. Due to this, not all protocols for notes were followed, but as stated earlier this term, we are wanting to give students as many opportunities as we can.

I know that the office staff have been extremely busy as the credit component of the POP system has been challenging for both parent/carers and the office staff. This has been another steep learning curve for the office and we appreciate your understanding in this matter. LATE ARRIVALS

It is very important that children attend school every day and we have seen an improvement in overall daily attendance. The school is now focusing on students attending school on time and not leaving early as the Department of Education has set specific school targets that we need to meet. 


