Wednesday 16th December, 2020.

Parents/Guests (limited to two people per family) are invited to attend the 2020 Graduation Ceremony for Year 6 students to be held on the bottom oval, **commencing at 2:30pm.** We have ventured to do an outdoor graduation so that our parents can be a part of this sentimental event in light of Covid restrictions. Parents are asked to enter the school via the staff carpark gate. There will be a table and QR code in which parents will register their attendance on the grounds. Parents will then walk down the ramp to the bottom oval. There will be crosses marked out on the grass, this specifies where parents may sit. Please bring a picnic blanket to sit on.


