- Do not be afraid of constructive criticism. Children usually understand when they have not met an expectation and can only improve if we help them e.g. you could say 'I think you could have done better. How could you improve for next time?'
- Help children see past challenges and use a growth mindset. Adding 'yet' is really helpful. For example, 'I can see you are disappointed that you can't solve that maths problem yet, but you will get there with more practice.'
- Promote your child's independence where you can. Children are often far more capable than we realise, until we give them the confidence to be independent.
- Don't compare your child to others.
   Encourage them to achieve their personal hest
- Keep shifting the goal posts in line with your child's capabilities and encourage your child to aim high.


