Centre for Education Statistics and Evaluation

This term our school, like many other public schools in the state, will participate in a Department of Education initiative: the *Tell Them Econg Me* student feedback survey. Students in years 4, 5 and 6 will complete the voluntary survey. The survey measures factors that are known to affect academic achievement and other student outcomes. The focus of the NSW-wide survey is on student wellbeing, engagement and effective teaching practices.

You may remember that our students also participated in a *Tell Them From Me* student survey in Term 3 last year. Asking students to complete this survey yearly allows us to identify trends in student responses as well as track engagement and motivation across grades.

The survey is a great opportunity for our students to provide us with valuable and quick feedback on what they think about school life, how engaged they are with school and the different ways that teachers interact with them. More than 6,300 schools in Australia and around the world have used *Tell Them From Me* to survey 5.4 million students. Capturing the voices of our students will help improve how we do things at our school and will inform the direction we head in for our new School Improvement Plan for 2021-2024.

We want to assure you that the survey is confidential. The survey is conducted online and will typically take less than 30 minutes to complete. It will be administered during school hours between 10 August and 23 October. Participating in the survey is entirely voluntary.


