Sibling orders can only be placed online – please do not ring the office to order sibling photos. Online orders for sibling photos must be purchased one business day before school photo day. Sibling photos will only be taken if an order has been placed. Late requests for sibling photos cannot be granted. We suggest you place your sibling order as soon as you receive the fiver with the order instructions and the code.

If your child is away on School Photo Day in Term 1, we organise a catch-up photo day for individual photos. 
