Term 2 Morning Drop Off and Afternoon Collection Routine

Dear parents and caregivers,

As previously announced by the Premier and Minister for Education, a phased operating model for our NSW schools during the COVID-19 outbreak will allow a managed return to school. This model will see students attending school one day a week commencing Week 3 –Monday 11th May. The plan is phased and flexible and will allow Dural Public School to slowly bring our school back to normal while balancing the health, learning and wellbeing needs of students, staff and our community.

Students of essential workers are still able to attend school every day.

On these allocated days that students attend school online learning will not be provided. If you choose to keep your child at home on their allocated day at school they can catch up on previous days learning. On days that are not student's allocated days, online learning will continue at home and at school.

Drop Off and Pick Up Routines

As parents and teachers need to adhere to the social distancing requirements, please see the structure of drop off/pick up routines below. These routines will commence **Monday Week 3** and will be in place until further communication. There will be a staggered pick up routine with students Kindergarten, Year 1, 2 and Year 3 finishing at **3:00pm** and students in Years 4, 5 and 6 will finish at **3:20pm**.

Dropping your child to school

At 8:50am children arriving at school go to the K-2 playground. A teacher will be on duty. At 9:00am Years 4 to 6 will be directed to the top grassed playground with teacher supervision. Please drop your child at the gate each morning.

Collecting your child from school

For Term 2 there will be a staggered collection of students each afternoon to reduce the amount of parents on site and to maintain social distancing. Teachers will walk their classes to their designated pick up point each afternoon.

K- 3 will be collected from their designated pick up point located at the top of the school at **3:00pm** each day.

Years 4-6 will be collected from their designated pick up point located at the top of the school at **3:20pm** each day.

Please see the table below for where your child will wait with their teacher to be collected. Parents are asked not to come into the playground or to the classrooms. If you have collected a child in K-3 and are waiting for an older sibling you need to wait outside school grounds.

Children catching the bus will continue to go straight to the bus shelter or walk across the bridge with the supervising teacher on duty.

Children attending OOSH will continue to follow after school OOSH procedures, with OOSH staff collecting K-2 students from the designated pick up areas and 3-6 students heading straight there at 3:20pm.
