Dear Parents/Caregivers,

The annual school swimming carnival will be held on Tuesday 25th February at Epping Aquatic Centre Epping. Students will travel by bus to the venue leaving school at 9am and returning to school by 3pm. Teachers in attendance have Emergency Care and C.P.R. Training.

Due to the nature of this event it is impossible to give exact starting times for all events. The carnival will commence at approximately 10am and conclude by 2:15pm. Students will be back at school by 3:10pm.

As the excursion involves water activities, the school requires that parents/caregivers complete a water competency assessment. Each child attending the pool will be required to wear a coloured wrist band signifying their level of water competency. An entry form is also included with this note. Parents are asked to assist students to enter the appropriate events.

All students from years 3-6 are expected to attend even if they are not participating. They will be there to support their peers. Those students in year 2 that are turning 8 years old this year are welcome to participate in their age races. Please only send your child if they are capable of swimming 50 metres.

Please ensure your child is protected with sunscreen and has a hat and towel. Students are asked to wear sports uniform on the day with costumes underneath. In a separate bag they should bring their under garments to change into for the trip back to school.

Cost, including transport by seat belted bus is \$20

Full payment, permission and swimming competency must be received at the office by Thursday 20th February. Payments after this date will not be accepted.

Please complete the permission note attached and return with payment to the office.

Unfortunately, the pool has only 5 lanes; as a result there will be no finals. All events will be timed finals.

- Students will need to bring their lunch in a plastic bag clearly labelled with their name and class. (No glass bottles or cans).
- No thongs, cameras, phones or jewellery are permitted.
- Events will be 50 metres in freestyle, backstroke, breaststroke and butterfly (age races).
- All children are encouraged to attend and to participate in events suited to their swimming ability.
- Please note only experienced squad swimmers should enter events such as the Medley and Butterfly.
- Parents are welcome to attend but must make their own way to the pool. Entry fee is \$2 for spectators, payable at the pool.
- When excursions are organised, every item has a cost transport, venue etc. This total cost is then
 divided by the number of students attending. If you have paid for this activity and your child does not
 attend, the school cannot cover the shortfall of funds. Therefore no refunds are possible.
- Parents taking their children from the pool must ensure that the teacher is aware. Parents will not be allowed to take other children home unless prior written permission has been obtained from their parent and given to the class teacher.
