<p><b>Voluntary</b></p>	<p>Anything labelled “<i>Voluntary</i>” is an optional contribution; there is no obligation to pay. These contributions provide much needed whole school resources and updated IT equipment. The school is very appreciative of your support if you are able to contribute.</p>
<p><b>Ceramic Tile</b></p> 	<p>Every student K-6 will design a tile to be displayed on a wall of a school building. The cost of the ceramic tile is only for new students to the school (Kindergarten, Year 5 OC and any new families in 2021).</p>
<p><b>Writing Journal</b></p>	<p>Every year students complete pieces of writing to add to their writing journal to show student growth throughout their learning journey. The cost of the writing journal is for new students to the school (Kindergarten, Year 5 OC and any new families in 2021). In Year 6 students will take their writing journal home.</p>
<p><b>School Magazine</b></p> 	<p>This literary publication is a monthly subscription where students are given a printed magazine as well as access to the digital School Magazine content in class. This is not a Dural specific magazine; it is used as a reading resource in the classroom for Years 3-6. <p><b>Resource Fee</b></p> 	<p>Every stage has been charged a resource fee for equipment in the classroom, including exercise books with the school logo on them for each subject, a class set of whiteboards, whiteboard markers, Write and Wipe sleeves, folders and general class stationery supplies.</p>
<p><b>Home Reading Levy</b></p>	<p>The K-2 Home Reading levy provides new home reading books for students to bring home to read throughout the year.</p>
<p><b>Essential Assessment</b></p> 	<p>This new program will be used K-6 this year. Teachers will be using this platform to assess students’ literacy and numeracy areas of focus. It will also be used to provide data to teachers to support learning programs within the classroom. Students will have access to MyLiteracy and MyNumeracy practise drills to improve their assessment scores.</p>
